







(a) Diagrammatic view. The vitreous humor is illustrated only in the bottom part of the eyeball.

(a) The outer segments of rods and cones are embedded in the pigmented layer of the retina.







(a) The three regions of the ear











(a) Taste buds are associated with fungiform, foliate, and circumvallate (vallate) papillae.
